She is currently working on a book titled: *The Living Home: Christian Communities & The Food They Eat*.

JASON EVANS is a student at Fuller Seminary and co-founder of The Ecclesia Collective, a network of faith communities, leaders, activists and artists committed to nurturing grassroots expressions of God's Kingdom in San Diego, CA. The churches he has helped start have been discussed in books such as *Emerging Worship* by Dan Kimball, *Emerging Churches* by Eddie Gibbs and Ryan Bolger, and *Jim & Casper Go To Church* by Jim Henderson and Matt Casper.
